Government Shutdown

Republicans are threatening to Shut Down Government as MILLIONS of Floridians Stand to Lose Health Care Coverage.

- Trump and Republicans are hellbent on unleashing a health care crisis onto Floridians even if it means shutting down the government.
- After Trump said, "Don't even bother dealing with [Democrats]," he's learning the hard way that Democrats don't work for him.
- Democrats have made our position clear. Leaders Schumer and Jeffries
 presented a proposal that would have reversed Republicans' cuts to Medicaid
 and prevented ACA premiums from skyrocketing, ensuring millions Floridians
 wouldn't lose their health insurance.
- To make matters even worse, after voting this plan down, Speaker Mike Johnson sent House Republicans home for a vacation.
- This goes to show you Republicans don't give a rat's tail about protecting Floridians' health only fattening their billionaire donors' pockets.

Life keeps getting more expensive, and eliminating property taxes may seem like a relief, but the truth is, those resources pay for things we all rely on and need, like public hospitals and health services, disaster preparedness and relief, firefighters and EMTs, and our schools.


- If we eliminate property taxes, the costs of those services don't just disappear; they shift onto us.

Redistricting Toolkit

Ron DeSantis is trying to rig the system—again. Pushing to draw district lines in the middle of the decade is expensive, unnecessary, and anti-democratic. Drawing district lines now will cost Florida taxpayers millions of dollars that would be better spent addressing the state's affordability crisis.
