



Dear Democrats,

Happy August! This month's FDP Weekends of Action are August 9-10 and August 23-24. Please join us or stand up an event near you to reenroll voters in Vote-by-Mail. We're hoping to set our next record for how many counties participate!

Since March, thousands of volunteers across Florida have knocked nearly 400,000 total doors and made almost 500,000 phone calls! See below to see how you can take action.

We're watching closely as Republicans in Texas work to steal Democratic Congressional seats with mid-decade redistricting. Republicans see the writing on the wall – Trump's chaotic leadership and Big Bullshit Bill are setting them up for disaster in 2026.

Florida is now one of a few states where Republican leadership is publicly weighing an unprecedented and anti-democratic choice to draw new district lines ahead of the midterm elections. No legislative process has begun, but the governor has said he is “looking very seriously” at changing the maps, and we all need to be ready to fight back. Our team has prepared a toolkit below with preliminary talking points, graphics and calls to action – and we'll continue to update as we learn more.

Florida Redistricting Toolkit


