I spent Saturday and Sunday on the ground in South Florida, knocking doors with candidates and talking directly with voters about the issues that matter most to their families and communities. Democrats across Florida are doing the same – organizing, listening, and building the relationships that will carry us through these final weeks.

Saturday night, I had the honor of delivering the opening address at the Miami-Dade Democratic Party's Blue Gala at the Frost Science Museum, standing alongside our full statewide ticket. Voter Registration

For National Voter Registration Week we hosted over 30 events, helped more than 835 people check their voter registration status, and registered over 290 people to vote! Shout out to the Palm Beach County DEC, the Hillsborough County DEC, the St. Johns County DEC, the Miami Beach Democratic Club, the Orange County Democratic Black Caucus, and all the other organizations who hosted VR events last week, and made National Voter Registration Week a success!



As a reminder, the voter registration deadline for the general election is **MONDAY, OCTOBER 5, 2026**. This is the last opportunity for people to register to vote in Florida, and be able to vote in the general election.

Poll Watchers: If you're comfortable observing and documenting, keep an eye on the in-person voting process to help ensure it runs fairly and smoothly.

Voter Assistance Hotline Agents: If you're a good listener who likes solving problems, help answer voters' questions on our hotline at [833-868-3352](tel:833-868-3352).

Ballot Cure Assistants: If you're detail-oriented and like helping people fix mistakes, help voters correct errors on their vote-by-mail ballots. These are errors that would otherwise keep their vote from being counted.
