

Martin County Commissioners

- Commissioners are elected for a four-year term
- Terms are staggered so there are always experienced commissioners. Districts 1, 3, and 5 are elected in presidential years. **Districts 2 and 4 are elected in the midterm Primary**
- Commissioner races are partisan
- There are 5 geographic districts numbered one to five. Commissioners are elected at-large, but they each represent a geographic district within the county
- Voters must only vote for the commissioner who represents their district
- Elections for commissioners takes place in the Primary election , not the General Election
- **Stacy Hetherington** and **Sarah Heard** are the two commissioners facing re-election in the August 2026 primary.
