Unfortunately, there is no Presidential ticket in 2026, but we do have a few opportunities to bring good government back to the nation.

- US Senate – elected every 6 years**

Rick Scott ran in 2024 for his second term and defeated Democrat Debbie Mucarsel-Powell by a margin of 12.8 percentage points. He will not be on the ballot again until 2030.

Ashley Moody, who was appointed in January 2025 by DeSantis to replace Marco Rubio, will be running in 2026 to hold onto her position as senator. She has 3 competitors in the primary election.

Lt. Col. Alexander Vindman and Angie Nixon are the two Democrats running for the Democratic Party nomination for Congress. The winner in August will likely oppose Ashley Moody in the November midterms.

- US House of Representative - elected every 2 years**

Brian Mast is our representative for CD 21. He has been our House Rep since 2017.

He last was re-elected in 2024 when he defeated Democrat Thomas Witkop, beating him by approximately 23 percentage points (277,435 votes vs 171,312 votes.)

James Martin and Bernard Taylor are two Democratic candidates who are challenging Mast.
